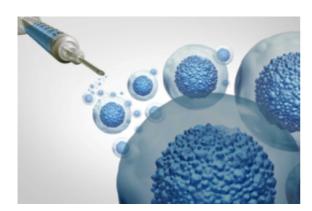


Happy new year! From all of us at MSK, we hope you had a relaxing and restful holiday period. We certainly did!

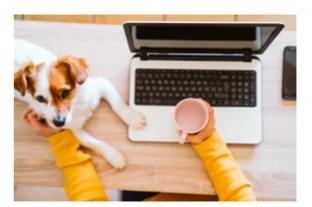
